- Byškovice, Lobkovice, Mlékojedy, Korycany and Horňátky belong to Neratovice too



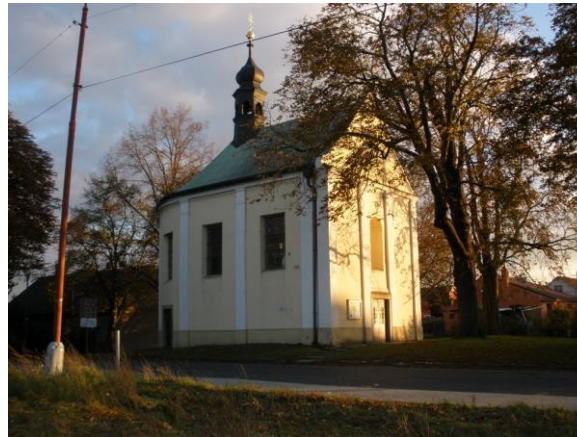
History of Neratovice

- First written mention of Neratovice is from 1227
- At the beginning of 15th century it was purchased by Lobkowitz family
- Neratovice quickly developed in the first half of 19th century thanks to industrial revolution
- In 1905, a chemical factory focused especially on ammonia production was established (Spolana)
- In 1957 Neratovice was upgraded to a town
